Pet Housing Agreement

The Inn and Spa at Honey Run welcomes quiet, non-aggressive canine companions when arrangements are made at the time of reservation. We want our guests to enjoy the company of their well-behaved dog while on vacation. The Inn reserves the option of limiting the number and size of pets on a case-by-case basis. All pet guests must be completely free of fleas and ticks, be well-groomed and up to date on shots and vaccinations. Advance pet reservations are required since The Inn has limited accommodations for pets. We have one pet-friendly loft.

Only dog guests who are quiet and non-aggressive toward other pets and people are invited to The Inn and Spa at Honey Run. The dog owner guest hereby agrees that The Inn is held harmless for any loss or injury or accident suffered by your dog while a visitor at The Inn. The dog owner also hereby agrees that any damage or injury caused by their dog to our property, inn guests, other inn guest's pets, inn cat or other inn pet's, or to any persons is the sole responsibility and liability of the owner.

- Dog guests are not to be left unattended in the loft at any time, unless they are in a crate. In order to preserve the peace and serenity we offer, dogs cannot be allowed to bark and disturb other guests.
- Please keep your dog on a leash when walking them. Guests accompanied by pets are responsible for cleaning up after pets; a trash can for waste disposal is located outside your loft. Only trails designated as "pet-friendly" are to be used by our canine guests.
- All dogs must sleep in their crates, carriers, or a pet bed. Dogs are not allowed on furniture or rugs. Dogs are only allowed in the designated pet-friendly loft. All public areas including the main lodge, Honeycombs, Monarch House, cottages, and restaurant are reserved for our people guests only.
- Only trails designated as "Pet Friendly" are to be used by our canine guests.
- There is an additional fee of \$35 per day for your pet, to be added to your accommodation charges, to cover the costs of additional cleaning. Your loft will be inspected after check out and any damages will be assessed and charged accordingly. If you are uncertain whether your dog may damage or soil the rug, we suggest you roll up any rugs so you avoid being charged for professional cleaning or replacement.

Any violation of this policy will cause eviction of the pet and owner off the premise. You will be responsible for lodging costs.
